I will never forget it.

It was past midnight. The crusade was over and I sat in an expensive home owned by the fine pastor of a very successful church. Two Cadillacs were parked on the drive. From outward appearance, life could not be better.

Yet, he was weeping.

There is a way out!

So, Paul encourages Thought-
